While the mill is down they are also planning on cutting the tailings line somewhere between the booster pump and the "Y" valve to see if there is tailings deposited in the bottom of the pipe. It would be very valuable to us (especially Harvey) if they could cut of a slice of the pipe so that we can look at how the pipe has worn as it has not been rotated since it was installed. Try to get them to slice of a section of the pipe (an inch or two) and send it to us in Vancouver.
