George Headley forwarded a copy of the Operation, Maintenance and Surveillance Manual, Mount Polley Project, Tailings Storage Facility for our review. Please note the following recommendations for the next edition of this OMS Manual.

- 1.12 Distribution of Manual
 - 1 copy only required for the Comptroller of Water Rights; this should be sent to the Dam Safety Unit. Public Safety Section, Victoria. This applies to the EPP as well
- 4.3 Instrumentation
 - Are the instrumentation objectives for the Stages 1a and 1b defined in the design report? If so there should be reference to them in the OMS report. The design objectives should answer the questions: what design assumptions are being monitored by the various instruments, what reading accuracy is required and what range of instrumentation readings are expected for the various reservoir levels? The objectives should identify in advance (where possible) the expected normal readings and the range of anomalies requiring investigation or alert.
